## 2021 Protocols for COVID-19

Our first priority is the health and safety of our students, families, and team. Every precaution will be taken to keep everyone safe, healthy and happy at T&V.

- These Protocols are effective June 14, 2021 (after the Kentucky mask mandate has ended on June 11), and may be amended as guidance continues to evolve.
- Masks are optional for students. Some Faculty may continue in masks for their own comfort and to support students who choose to mask.
- Students will be distanced for both center and across-the-floor work.
- Class sizes have a limited capacity. Students remain with their classmates for the duration of their class time and do not switch rooms.
- The studio is sanitized nightly.
- Classroom activities will involve limited touch (hand-holding, high fives, etc.)
- Students will participate in our Drop-Off/Pick-Up Program, to ensure a safe and organized class transition and a quiet and focused studio environment. The lobby areas will be available for parents of PreDance I and II students only. All other parents may drop-off and pick-up students according to our Arrival/Dismissal procedures.
