## Jack-Be-Nimble

(45 Minutes, Once Per Week)

Begin with a strong foundation. Jack-Be-Nimble is the perfect first class for your little one. Prepare your child well for pre-school and beyond, by gaining confidence and independence. They will develop core strength, and enhance gross motor skills, while they delight in creative play and cooperative learning with caring and supportive teachers. There's no better way to begin!

Monthly Tuition \$60 Each lesson meets 45 minutes, once per week.

## Ballet, Jazz, Tap & Core Strength

## Hip Hop & Core Strength Fusion



Explore the fast-paced and fun genre of Hip Hop (street dance to contemporary music) while building body strength and core muscles.

We recommend supplementing your full-year training with this additional year-round class. However, students may take this class as a stand-alone option as well.

Monthly Tuition \$58

Each class meets one hour, once per week and will perform one recital piece.
